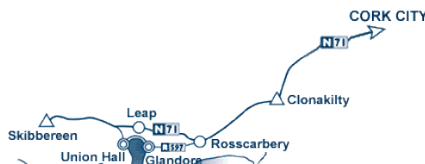
Originally a pub, the old shop front has been replaced by one made of Irish Elm. The hand etched glass that adorns the front of the building is the work of local artist, Frank Maher.
